What is the Gold Nugget Derby? This is a winter activity for Cub Scouts so that they can have fun, work as a team, learn and develop skills. The MOTTO of the day is "DO YOUR BEST".

Clothing: Cub Scouts need good outdoor winter clothing such as thermal underwear, gloves, hats, warm coats, socks and boots. Be prepared for a cold day – even if it isn't. You will be outside for about 4 hours so bear this in mind when preparing for the day: dress in layers, so that the layers can be removed if you're hot or added if you're cold.

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Objective:

To provide Cub Scouts an opportunity to test their skills and teamwork in a fun and competitive environment. This event is much like a Klondike Derby, all levels of Cub Scouts are allowed to participate.

The Event:

The event will be made up of several stations, called cities where the mayor is in charged. The mayor will explain the event and judge. After the den has completed visiting all of the cities they will check in at registration area. It is the responsibility of each den to secure and protect their beads throughout the event.

Arrival Instructions:

Registration will begin promptly at 9:30 a.m. All Cub Scout dens must register at the registration desk to receive their derby instructions and to be logged into the event. All registration will be completed by 9:50 a.m. in time for the opening ceremony in "The Lodge". PLEASE be on time, as this is a huge event that relies heavily on time constraints and schedules.

Volunteers :
