

**Is any Special Equipment Needed?** An equipment list will be sent to each participant after the reservation is received. Youth who participate in an active unit outdoor program probably already have the necessary personal equipment. An *official Boy Scout or Venturing uniform* is required. Each participant should make sure that badges and insignia are properly placed and that the uniform is worn correctly.

**What About Medical Forms?** A medical history for all campers is required by the code of New York State. Forms will be sent to Scout when he signs up for course. All medicals forms must have been completed within one year of end of course (September 11, 2011).

**What Does the Conference Cost?** The conference fee is \$275.00, which includes all food, equipment, and training materials. Early Bird fee is \$255.00 if paid by June 15th. Regular fee is \$275.00 if received after June 15th. NYLT counts as a 2nd week in camp. An additional \$15.00 discount is available if the Scout attends one of the Baden-Powell Council summer camps. A deposit of \$50.00 per scout should accompany each registration. The balance must be paid by July 31, 2010. Scholarships may be available from the Baden-Powell Council - apply early. The fee does not cover personal uniform and equipment nor transportation to and from camp.

*Scouts who do not pre-register may not be able to attend the conference. The course has room for only a limited number of participants. If you are thinking of sending Scouts to NYLT, please sign them up early to hold a place.*

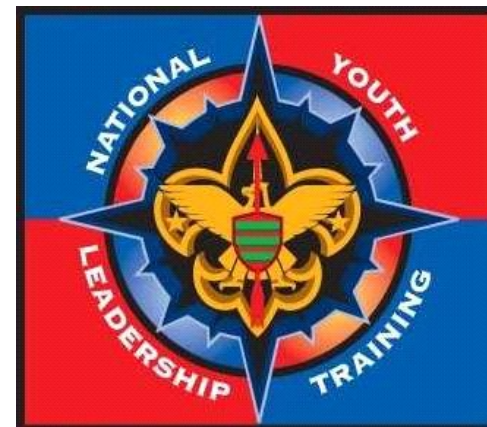

# NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING CONFERENCE

**Purpose:** The training of youth leaders in a unit is important in helping individual Youth and the unit grow. The Boy Scouts of America has developed **National Youth Leadership Training Conference** (NYLT), that has proven valuable in the training of youth leaders. The conference will stress leadership to make youth leaders more effective in their unit.

Perhaps more importantly, the youth will be exposed to living skills that allow him to become a successful leader in any organization. This course will provide the youth with tools that he/she needs to develop their leadership potential. The skills he/she will learn will enhance the Scoutmaster's/Crew Advisor's leadership development of the youth and directly benefit the unit's program.

**Qualifications:** Youth must be at least 13 years old (but not yet 18), and approved to attend by his **Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor**. He/She should be currently or will be filling a Troop/Crew leadership position or will be, in the near future. It is expected that the Youth will have camping, cooking and hiking skills.

**Location and Time:** The conference will be held over two weekends from August 13-15th at Camp Tuscarora, and Sept 9-11th at Camp Barton. The conference will be led by Course Director Bob Steele and conducted by an excellent group of experienced youth and adult trainers.

## NYLT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**What is the Conference?** The National Youth Leadership Training Conference is a week long outdoor experience for youth leaders in support of the Scoutmaster's responsibility for training the unit's youth leaders. It is conducted by the Baden-Powell Council's Training Committee using a syllabus published by the Boy Scouts of America.

NYLT replaces the Junior Leader Training Conference, which was last offered in 2004.

**What is the purpose?** Scouting recognizes that Scoutmasters and Crew Advisors have the responsibility of training their own youth leaders. The purpose of the National Youth Leadership Training Conference is **NOT** to assume the leader's role, but to support it. The conference's objectives are:

1. To enhance the relationship between the participant and his adult leader.
2. To have fun.
3. To give participants a basic knowledge of the skills of leadership and help them relate these skills to their unit responsibilities.
4. To give the participants the opportunity to share ideas and experiences with youth from other units.
5. To give participants the confidence and knowledge to run the unit program.
6. To create an atmosphere where youth will experience Scouting at its best.
