



Requirements for the International Activity Badge



This award can be earned by Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts. Information on Jamborees and the International Youth Exchange Emblem are available on the web at www.usscouts.org/advance/intYouthExch.asp. **There must be seven requirements completed: three from category one, three from category two and one from category three.** Requirements from one category cannot be exchanged for one in another category. Complete the application form and turn it in to the Scout Service Center for approval.

This is a temporary patch worn on right pocket. It is **NOT** worn in place of or alongside the World Crest emblem.

Category 1: Complete 3 of the following

- Earn the interpreter strip
- Earn Citizenship in the World Merit Badge
- Conduct an international project such as UNICEF, United Nations Day, etc.
- Visit a Cub Scout or Boy Scout group in another country
- Host a Scout or Scouter from another country
- Earn the World Conservation Award
- Supervised e-mail or snail mail pen-pal projects with non-US troops/Packs or correspond with a relative in another country
- Participate in a collection for Scouting's World Friendship Fund

Category 2: Complete 3 of the following

- Participate in a BSA event with a World Brotherhood theme such as Expo, Day Camp, Summer Camp or Camporee
- Participate in Jamboree-On-The-Air, or similar Scouting program
- Participate in an international theme program at a troop or pack meeting
- Visit an international organization, embassy, World Bank, UN and learn more about what they do
- Visit an international civic club and learn about their international activities
- Assist at an IVIS (international visitors information service) at a train, bus or airport station
- Participate in an extracurricular activity involving foreign students (music, sports)
- Interview a foreign exchange student

Category 3: Complete 1 of the following

- Assist at an IVIS (international visitors information service) at a train, bus or airport station
- Attend/participation in a World Jamboree (Sweden 2011) in another country or BSA sponsored Scouting Tour in another country (Pan American Jamboree, Mexican Jamboree 2009)
- Cub Scouts only: be able to converse in a foreign language
- Serve as a staff member in a European Camp program
- Collect international Scout badges or pins and display at a troop/pack Court of Honor/ Pack meeting (a minimum of 40-50 badges/pins)
- Earn International Youth Exchange Emblem
- Work in a job where you are exposed to a foreign language
